Information Request EFSB-W-8

Refer to the Application at 5-13. In what stage of development is the Company's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan ("SWPPP") for the Project? If not finalized, indicate when the Company anticipates that it will complete its SWPPP. Please provide a copy of the SWPPP in its present stage of development

Supplemental Response

In its original response to this Information Request, the Company anticipated developing the SWPPP as part of its Notice of Intent ("NOI") to the EPA in the first quarter of 2019, and a submittal of these documents in the second quarter of 2019. However, at the time of the original response to Information Request EFSB-W-8, the Company anticipated a Spring 2019 project start. This is consistent with the Company's typical approach regarding submittal of the SWPPP and NOI approximately two to three months before construction work commences, as discussed in the response to Information Request EFSB-S-1. However, due to schedule adjustments as part of this proceeding and local permitting process, the start date is expected to be pushed past the second quarter of 2019.
