NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a/ Eversource Energy ("Eversource"), Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid"), and Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company d/b/a Unitil ("Unitil") (collectively, the "Companies") submit this letter in reply to the Motion to Dismiss filed by Commonwealth Wind LLC ("Commonwealth Wind") in the above-referenced proceedings.

The Department should deny Commonwealth Wind's Motion to Dismiss. Commonwealth Wind negotiated and executed comprehensive Purchase Power Agreements with the Companies that are now before the Department for approval following a full and fair adjudicatory process. Approving the Motion to Dismiss at this very late stage would significantly undermine what to date has been a very successful process established in Massachusetts to encourage the development of offshore wind projects.

Accordingly, based on substantial record evidence, the Department should approve the power purchase agreements the Companies have executed with Commonwealth Wind *and* Mayflower Wind LLC to acquire respective, *pro rata* shares of the energy and associated Environmental Attributes from the developers' aggregate 1,605 MW of Offshore Wind Energy Generation.
