On behalf of NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Company”), please find enclosed the Company’s monthly arrearage tracking spreadsheets for December 2022, January 2023, and February 2023, pursuant to D.P.U. 20-58-A. which include highlighting of cells corrected on April 17, 2023. Upon review, the only cells corrected for these months correspond to Section 8 of the of the NSTAR Electric-East data file, not Sections 6, 7, and 8 as previously indicated. Three cells of Section 8 of the NSTAR Electric-East data files have been corrected for each of these months, as highlighted in yellow in the ‘Corrected and Highlighted’ copies. These corrections are due to a data formatting error affecting the data reported in previous monthly reports.
