Re: DPU 20-75-B Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company d/b/a Unitil Annual Report on DG Project Withdrawals

Dear Secretary Marini:

In its November 24, 2021 Order in the above-referenced docket the Department indicated that it did not anticipate that Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light Company d/b/a Unitil ("Unitil" or the "Company") will submit any capital investment projects (CIPs) consistent with the criteria for the Provisional Program as set forth in the Order. DPU 20-75-B, Order at 41. However, "to assist the Department in its evaluation of the Provisional Program," the Department directed Unitil to "continue its evaluation of DG applications and determine any DG projects that likely would withdraw from Unitil's DG interconnection queue due to anticipated high interconnection costs." Id. at 42. The Department directed the Company to report the results of its evaluation each year on February 1st for the previous calendar year. Id.

Due to an inadvertent oversight, the Company did not make the required reports on February 1, 2022 or 2023 for the calendar years 2021-22. Per the Department's instruction, Unitil hereby reports that it did not receive any notices in 2021, 2022, or 2023 from DG interconnection applicants that they were withdrawing from the queue due to anticipated high interconnection costs.
