**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

NSTAR Electric Company, NSTAR Gas Company, and Eversource Gas Company of Massachusetts each d/b/a Eversource Energy (the “Company”) pursuant to 220 C.M.R. 1.02(5), hereby requests an extension of time to file its monthly arrearage tracking spreadsheets pursuant to D.P.U. 20-58-A issued by the Department of Public Utilities on June 26, 2020. Specifically, the Company requires an extension of time through April 15, 2024, to file its monthly arrearage tracking spreadsheets with the D.P.U. 20-58 working group for February 2024 arrearage information.

The Company has good cause to request an extension of time due to the transition to a new customer information system (known as OMNI) that is resulting in several data anomalies for the Western Massachusetts region of NSTAR Electric. The Company expects that these data anomalies will be resolved during a monthly OMNI update, and that the Company will have accurate data after this update occurs. Because all Eversource affiliates in Massachusetts submit their monthly arrearage tracking spreadsheets in a single filing, the Company is requesting this extension apply to all affiliates to ensure the data sets can be submitted together as normal once the February 2024 data becomes available. The Company requires additional time through April 15,

2024 to ensure it is providing thorough and accurate information in the monthly arrearage tracking spreadsheets. Without this extension of time, the Company will be required to knowingly file inaccurate spreadsheets and subsequently file revised monthly arrearage tracking spreadsheets once accurate information becomes available.


The Company will make every effort to file its February 2024 arrearage tracking spreadsheets with the working group as soon as possible. However, for the reason stated above, the Company respectfully requests an extension the delaying the monthly filing until approximately April 15, 2024.
